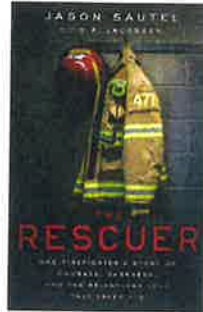




## THE RESCUER

by Candace Cameron Bure

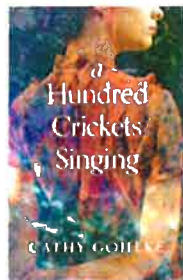
